Plans for 2014—First priority is to revise the Riesling and Rattler Trail brochure, including the map.

Other signage and amenities projects for 2014 (with help from the Maintenance subcommittee):

- Relocate the km distance marker posts to their accurate spot and replace faded metal km signs. Accurate locations have now been marked.
- 2. Install toilet signs.
- An elevation sign (showing entire Trail gradients) at the highest point (Penwortham) and also at Lennon Street Park and Auburn.
- 4. To improve directions to the start of the Trail at Auburn.
- 5. Additional (historical) information at Lennon Street park.
- 6. Update Trail signs (to include Barinia section) at Clare, Sevenhill, Watervale and Auburn.

Distance Markers along the Riesling Trail

The somewhat curious and observant users of the Trail have asked what the small numbered pegs represent. There are two sets of these:

One set is numbered white pegs (25mm x 25mm square) from Auburn to Barinia. These are the new locations for the kilometre distance posts. The original locations were approx. 40m out per kilometre, so nearly a kilometre out over the Auburn to Clare section! The new locations have been measured to 1m accuracy using a differential GPS. New metal plates will be fitted to replace the faded ones when the posts are shifted. This will be by the middle of the year.

For the record, the distance from Lennon Street park to the station at Auburn is 25.1km and from the Lennon Street park to Barinia is 7.6km.

The second set of short white pegs (50mm x 50mm) are the SA Road Runners Club distance markers for the half marathon, 10km and 5km courses. These start at the southern end of the wide section on Station Road, Clare. These are accurate to within 10cm. The 10km turn-around is at the culvert a few hundred metres south of Quarry Road bridge. The turn-around for the half marathon is just south of the Horrocks tree sign at Penwortham. The 5km course is on the northern section towards Barinia and the turn-around is in the pine avenue south of the 6km to Barinia post. All 3 courses finish on the town oval.
