Users of the Riesling Trail will notice that there are fewer olives than there used to be. This is part of a program to control them completely along the Riesling and Rattler

Trails. If left untouched they will continue to spread and choke out the native bushland.

This project has been funded by a Northern and Yorke NRM Community Grant, through the Clare and Gilbert Valleys Council. The management committee will continue to remove all olives and control any regrowth or seedlings. Fox Tree Lopping has assisted with clearing olive trees from the cuttings.


