From the Chairman

The Riesling Trail looks especially scenic now that spring is here – wattles and other shrubs are in full flower and with strong aromas to go with it.

Recent developments along the trail include completion of a new bridge at the northern end of the Watervale Station, surfacing the section of the trail next to Station Road in Clare and reworking the car park at the southern end of Station Road. This is to partition off the trail from the park with bollards and to refreshening the garden there. Thanks to Clare Quarry and the Clare and Gilbert Valleys Council for helping out with this work. Our plan is to put bollards next to the trail along Station Road to deter people from driving onto the trail and to make it safer for trail users. We have also installed seats south of Sevenhill station (donated by the Cameron–Hill family) and north of Hubbe Road (donated by Neighbourhood Watch).

As part of our on-going olive clearance program, we recently completed removal of olives next to the trail in the Watervale station area with funding from the Northern and Yorke Landscapes Board. This was quickly followed up with tree planting along the boundary, with trees supplied by the Upper Wakefield Landcare Group. Events coming up include our AGM at 7pm on Thursday 13th October at the Bentley's Hotel. Here our guest speaker will be Renee Thompson from Crown Lands addressing the topic of land ownership of the Riesling Trail. This is fundamental to the on-going security of the Riesling Trail. We welcome all friends of the trail to come and contribute to ideas for future developments along the trail. There will also be an Open Garden at Mark and Jo Healy's at Watervale on 8th and 9th of October, with proceeds going towards the Monica McInerney sculpture. More details for this Open Garden will be available closer to the date. And speaking of the sculpture, we can now confirm that the opening of this, by Monica, will be on

As always, thank you to all who have supported the trail financially and in other ways. This includes those who helped recently with clearing a fallen tree.




