

The big news recently has been the opening of the sculpture next to the Station Master's house in Clare. This will be a great feature for the trail in recognition of one of Clare's most famous citizens, Monica McInerney. With the skill of local artist, Paul Leditschke, and generous donations from the community, the concept of Mayor Allan Aughey from several years ago has finally been achieved. We are also grateful to Jason Gill and Trevor Mace for the tricky job of installing this fine piece of artwork. The opening by Monica was a rather touching ceremony on a very pleasant late afternoon next to the trail. Special thanks also to Sue Wurst and her helpers for organising this special event.

Back on the trail, we have had a few instances of trail wash with the heavy rainfall this spring. This is especially just north of Wakefield Road and just south of Barinia. Please bear with us as we need to put in extra piping and other drainage before undertaking trail resurfacing. It is especially at times like these that your donations to the Riesling Trail are put to very good use.

As part of our bridge replacement program, the bridge just north of Tatkana Road will be replaced by mid-year. We may have to close off this section of trail for a week or so, but will give plenty of notice if this is to be the case.

We welcome new committee members, Mick Mittiga and Larn McMurray, elected at our recent Riesling Trail AGM and look forward to their contribution. The address by Crown Lands has prompted us to follow up in the new year, especially in relation to land tenure so use of the trail land is more secure.

But right now, I am visiting the Otago Rail Trail in the South Island of New Zealand – as aways looking for ideas on how we can improve our trail.

Trust you are enjoying using the Riesling Trail through the summer months.

Trail committee. It depicts me as a 10-year-old booklover, when I would sit on the


roof of my family house opposite, lost in reading. As it says on the plaque, everything I do as a writer is because I'm a reader.

Allan Mayfield, Chairman was presented with a 'Friend Forever' Certificate for his outstanding contributions to the Riesling Trail.






Winner-Best Tourism Restaurant
