# From the Chairman

Spring brings a lot of colour and fragrances to the Riesling Trail, making it that much more enjoyable. That is, so long as you can avoid the odd territorial magpie for the next month or so.

A couple of weeks ago we had the opening of a new shelter next to the Wakefield River bridge, just north of Auburn. This is a rather grand looking sound-shell feature, built by Clare Metal Fabrications and the site prepared by the team from JC Gill (all called 'Gilly'!). The shelter was donated by Stephanie Toole from Mount Horrocks Wines and the seat by the U3A Coffee and Chat group. This is the second seat they have donated to the Riesling Trail. We are most grateful for these donations, and also to the volunteers who helped put up the shelter and seat and do the landscaping.

The next project, scheduled for later this year, is replacing the bridge next to College Road in Sevenhill. We will also seal each side of College Road and add line markings to improve safety to trail users at this crossing.

I recently met up with Andrew Moylan to help add more Mawson Trail directional signs where it connects with the Riesling Trail – this is at Auburn and near the northern end, south of Barinia. Interestingly, Andrew was very involved, together with Terry Lavender, with the development of the Riesling Trail many years ago. On 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of October there will be an Open Garden at Mark and Jo Healey's, west of Watervale. Part of the gate entrance fee will be donated to the Riesling Trail, for which we are most grateful.

Finally, you are all welcome to our AGM on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> October at 7pm at the Visitor Information Centre, Clare. Our guest speaker will be Sally Haynes, Manager of the Centre, speaking on Tourism and the Riesling Trail. Look forward to seeing you there.
