# From the Chairman

One of our key objectives is to keep the Riesling Trail looking good so it is enjoyed by all. This includes keeping it tidy with no sticks or litter on the trail and pruning back any encroaching branches. Thank you to all those who help out here in any way. Occasionally we have to move quickly to clear a fallen tree of fix up any wash from rainstorms. This was the case recently when Doug May & John Koch helped repair rutting in the pathway from the trail up to Pinks Reserve. The occasional litter, including tissues and dog dropping bags (with droppings inside!), left next to the trail is a bit disappointing, hence the signage to try to rectify this behaviour.

As part of our bridge replacement program, a new bridge next to College Road in Sevenhill was installed recently. This was again done by the team with JC Gill who have done two other bridges. A major reason for these replacements is to fit steel beams in place of the timber beams (used after the rail line was scrapped) and so will have a much longer life. These new bridges have pipe side railings which are safer than timber and need virtually no maintenance. The next bridge on the list is near the 7km to Clare marker, north of Jollys Way (Mintaro Road). We will also seal each side of College Road and Jollys Way in the next few weeks and add line markings to improve safety for trail users at these crossings.

We are also improving drainage to stop any future wash of the trail north of Wakefield Road. This work, being done by Clare Quarry, includes putting a decentsized pipe under the trail to prevent water washing onto the trail. They will also repair the trail surface along the cutting south of this point, which was damaged by heavy rains last year.

At our recent AGM there was a change in committee membership, with Peter Wood leaving and Tony Siebert joining the committee as treasurer. Peter's contribution to the Riesling Trail has been enormous. He was a committee member for something like 20 years and treasurer for the past 10 years. Peter was also very involved with the development of the northern section of the trail to Barinia and the Lennon Street car park in Clare. He also recorded the counts on our five Trakers along the trail each month without fail, or lined someone else to do it in his absence. Peter has amazing energy and we only needed to mention that something needed to be done, and next thing he has done it.






