From the Chairman



Welcome to our Spring edition of the Riesling Trail Newsletter. Spring is certainly the best time of year, with green countryside and some nice fragrances, such as from the English broom. Our trail user numbers for the past three months are on a par with last year – 19,701 vs 20,182 for 2023, so the trail is as popular as ever.

We have had a lot of publicity in the past couple of months marking the 30th year since the opening of the first section of the Riesling Trail, from Sevenhill to Watervale in 1994. This includes a radio interview, Facebook postings and a feature article in BikeSA magazine. Thank you to Gabrielle Jones for putting the story together and organising the publicity. The next big nationwide publicity will be screening of the Riesling Trail as part of SBS television Great Australia Walks series. This will be on Thursday 24th of October at 7:30pm. We were delighted to be one of nine trails around Australia to be selected for this current series. It will feature great shots of the trail as well as interesting stories from locals. Filming was done over three days earlier this year. A further bit of publicity will be a stop-off to show the Melbourne Cup (yep, the real thing!) at the Lennon Street park around midday on Sunday 22nd of September. This will be taken to a few locations in Clare that day, including the Racecourse and Visitor Information Centre.

We are continuing to upgrade the trail, with more work due to be done this spring. This includes replacing another bridge (midway between Maynard Road & Wendouree Road) and sealing at four more crossings. These crossings will have line markings to improve safety for trail users. Trust you are not inconvenienced much during this work. There will shortly be a new drinking fountain (donated by SA Water) next to the trail at the southern park next to Station Road in Clare. We are also planning to install several more along the trail, including one at Auburn. Some of the regular trail users may have spotted a spruced-up gum tree just north of Quarry Road bridge. We decided that this tree was too important to let mistletoe take over so we contracted a crew from Adelaide to climb up and cut it out. Because of the cost we will be very selective about what other trees we fix in the future.

And it's also that time of year for our AGM, on Thursday 10th of October at 7pm at the Clare Town Hall (Barbara J Long Room). To add a broader perspective, our guest speaker will be Mike Keller, an avid visitor to cycling trails around the world.




